

Roach Treatment Preparation

Before Service Can Be Performed

The following must be done before the Service Technician's arrival. It may not be possible for him to perform the service if the following is not done.

- 1. Remove all food, dishes and other items from the kitchen cabinets, cupboards and drawers and place them in another room. Cover all items, especially food.
- 2. Remove all items from the bathroom cabinets, drawers, closets, and medicine chests and place them in another room.
- 3. Remove all items from any closets, desks, dressers, etc. where roaches have been observed.
- 4. Remove all pets, including birds and fish from your home. If the fish tank cannot be readily removed from the house, unplug the air pump, and cover the tank with plastic wrap, foil, or damp towels. Birds must be out of the area for 24 hours. Any exotic pets or animals may need to be kept out for longer periods of time (e.g., tarantulas, reptiles, etc.) Pestgon is not responsible for any animals, including birds and fish, which are left in the home.
- 5. Vacate your home for a minimum of three hours from the time work starts or until the chemical is dry.
- 6. Cover all toys, including stuffed animals.
- 7. Those persons allergic to insecticides, those with respiratory problems and those who are pregnant may need to vacate the premises for a longer period. Check with your physician.

When you return:

- 1. Open the Windows.
- 2. Do not wash shelves for 4 weeks. All necessary cleaning of shelves should be done prior to treatment. Shelves may be wiped with a dry paper towel.
- 3. Check all boxes and bags for roaches before returning them to cabinets.
